Observation: The Registrant did not have policies in place regarding persons who are visiting staff members.				

Actions taken or to be taken by Registrant (Operator): The Registrant must develop a policy regarding staff having visitors on site and provide that policy to the Assisted Living Registry (the Registry).

Actions taken or to be taken by Registry: Review policy.

A registrant may accept a person as a resident by making a written residency agreement with the person that includes all of the applicable content set out in Schedule C, which states a registrant must include whether any persons residing in the assisted living residence are not residents and, if so, whether those persons will have access to the common areas of the assisted living residence. Observation: The Registrant did not provide residents with information about person(s) living and visiting the residence who were non-residents or provide information regarding access of those person (s) to the common areas of the residence.				

Actions taken or to be taken by Registrant (Operator): The Registrant must provide the Registry with an updated residency agreement that includes information relating to any non-residents living on site.

If any non-residents are living on site, the Registrant must develop a policy regarding access to the common areas, as outlined in <u>section 15 (2) (b)</u> of the regulation.

The Registrant must provide the Registry with written confirmation that residents have been informed of changes to the residency agreement after the updated residency agreement has been reviewed and accepted by the Registry.

Actions taken or to be taken by Registry: Review the updated residency agreement, and policy if applicable.

Requirement: Section 61 (2) (b) Service Provision Generally. A registrant must ensure that assisted living services are provided by individuals who have the necessary training, experience, skills and other qualifications to provide the service. Observation: The Registrant did not ensure the staff providing assistance with medication had the necessary training, experience, skills and other qualifications. Medication policies and processes are outdated and do not				
align with the current practice.				

Actions taken or to be taken by Registrant (Operator): The Registrant must provide the Registry with updated medication policies and processes.

The Registrant must also develop, and provide the Registry with a plan on how and when staff training will occur on the updated polices and processes as well as a training plan for new staff.

Actions taken or to be taken by Registry: Review medication policies and processes and training plan.

A registrant who provides assistance with administering medication must ensure that medication is administered only by the resident, or a health professional, or a certified non-registrant within the meaning of the Health Professions Act, who is authorized under that Act to administer the medication.			Compliance Action: Required actions yet to be completed by the Registrant.	
Observation: The Registrant did not have documentation demonstrating that staff had been appropriately delegated to administer medication.				

Actions taken or to be taken by Registrant (Operator): The Registrant must provide the Registry with documentary evidence for each staff member who has been delegated to perform assistance with medication.

Actions taken or to be taken by Registry: Review documentation.
